





To exchange views regarding the history and current position/performance of Forum Merapi.


- > Forum Merapi was established in 2008

# CONCLUSIONS

- Majority FKM members aware that in the attempt of mitigating the disaster risk due to primary and secondary disaster of Mt. Merapi, it is important to increase the information quality (quick and accurate).
- Majority FKM members agree to have some sort of consortium to support the Mt.Merapi-related disaster risk mitigation program, and expect that such consortium should be complementing (empower and strengthen) with currently available systems/practices.
- The partnership-based approach needs to be the real commitment where all members within the consortium are expected to activate the consortium to support disaster risk mitigation program in a simple but accountable manners.
